Newborn babies have very weak immune systems. That means they aren't able to fight off infections easily. Some infections can lead to your baby needing to go to the hospital. Sadly, this can even lead to death.

Here's the good news!

Diseases and vaccines to protect babies have been studied for a very long time.

We have learned that when we give some vaccines to pregnant people, it safely gives some protection against harmful diseases to their unborn child. When the baby is born, that protection stays with them while they are most at risk of serious disease.
